

# Call for Participation – research trip "Open perspectives: Expanding Audience Engagement and Dialogue in Contemporary Art between Germany and Türkiye"

Engage audiences, broaden perspectives, build networks. Our research trip brings together museum professionals from Germany and Türkiye. Together, you'll explore how museums can reach new audiences for contemporary art taking into account different institutional and societal contexts. The historical and societal connections between Germany and Türkiye offer diverse starting points for this objective, which can be further nurtured through artistic exchange, dialogue, and audience development. During the trip, you will expand your professional network, identify institutional needs and highlight funding opportunities made possible through international collaboration.

The 18th Istanbul Biennial provides a timely occasion for discussing these issues on the ground: Can large-scale cultural events act as catalysts for long-term public engagement? Do they create sustainable structures? How do they foster civic dialogue?

Over four days, you will visit museums and contemporary art institutions in Istanbul, gaining insight into outreach and participation strategies from colleagues based in the cities of İzmir and Ankara, as well as other places across Türkiye. Together, you will explore how museums can engage new audiences through international collaboration.

- An extensive programme including institutional visits, talks and presentations, and networking events
- Insights into curatorial approaches and audience engagement strategies from across Türkiye
- Exchanges with Turkish and German museum professionals

- Professionals working in museums of contemporary art
- Museum professionals with a strong interest in audience development and international collaboration

- Professional experience relevant to the themes explored during the trip
- Engagement with strategies for audience development
- A demonstrable interest in international cultural exchange
- Motivation to participate and potential for long-term collaboration
